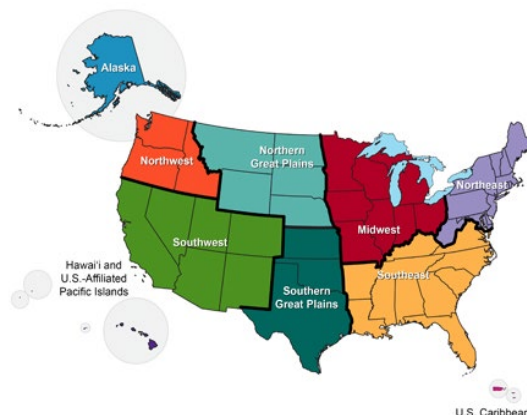


FREE National Climate Resilience Training for the Tribal Water Sector

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) [Creating Resilient Water Utilities](#) (CRWU) initiative is providing a series of **free** webinars for tribal water sector utilities and other water sector stakeholders.

Who Should Attend? Owners, operators, practitioners and environmental managers from tribal drinking water, wastewater and stormwater utilities, as well as contractors that service these utilities and other water sector stakeholders. These webinars focus on building resilience to the impacts of climate change, identifying adaptation strategies, and tribal utility infrastructure financing.
