The New England Water Infrastructure Network (NEWIN) helps communities access Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding for drinking water, wastewater, stormwater, and nonpoint source pollution needs through the Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds (SRFs) and other sources.

NEWIN offers **FREE** financial, managerial, and technical support for the region's municipalities, water utilities, and tribes. We prioritize working with disadvantaged communities, those with pressing water quality challenges, and water systems that have not previously applied for SRF funding.
